Highlights From Headquarters

- In April, we had an Evening of Impact where twelve local churches gathered to learn more about the ministry of MAG, the work God is doing in Honduras, and all the needs we have in order to continue our ministry. It was a powerful night with all the local churches in person, plus 40 churches total represented with 26 online watch parties all over the United States!
- Our Apprentice Program continues to thrive with individuals completing their training and being sent out to ministry all over the world. This year, we graduated an apprentice who moved to Alaska to serve. We also welcomed two new apprentices who are flying and training in preparation for life on the field, both with a desire to missionary work in Africa.
- Additionally, we had an airplane donated to us, that our team is preparing to sell for seed money for our next Cessna 206 field aircraft.

Earlier this year, we had a patient who had broken both bones in her forearm. She resisted getting in the airplane to go to the city, but finally agreed to go. However, the day of the flight she called us and said that she wasn't going to go. "I believe in the herbs that I can use," she said. "I feel afraid and I think that God is telling me to stay." With the help of a trusted elder in the village we talked to her on the phone for about 20 minutes, walking her through the anxiety.

Ultimately the decision was hers, but we knew that without a surgery she would lose the use of her arm. As we stood around the phone we were called into prayer; the devil was using fear to destroy what could be a blessing. After a few moments, she agreed to be ready when the plane came to get her.

Today she is a whole woman!
